Undeterred by challenges, the college has consistently achieved outstanding academic results, nurtured leadership qualities, and fostered a culture of innovation and holistic development. Our Vision and Mission focus on providing value-based education while instilling leadership, creativity, and social responsibility among students. This year, the successful implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has been a cornerstone, bringing ground-breaking changes to curriculum and pedagogy and aligning the institution with national education goals.

The year was a tapestry of exceptional accomplishments. The construction of the college's permanent building commenced, marking a significant step toward infrastructural growth.
